

Dear Year 11 students and parents/carers

Firstly we like to take this opportunity to thank Year 11 students and their parents for their ongoing commitment to their examinations and their support of Axe Valley Academy. It is evident that this year group is dedicated to their examinations and working with a focus on their academic achievement. The exemplary behaviour and attitude displayed every day has put the current Year 11s in the position of potentially achieving the most impressive results at AVA to date. It is a pleasure to go into lessons and see students striving to achieve the very best that they can.

With such a hardworking year group, who are showing excellent organisation and motivation toward their revision, we wanted to take the opportunity to write to you outlining the support strategies we are putting in place for Year 11 in the countdown to the GCSE public examinations in May.

The following letter is a comprehensive summary of the different timetabling expectations, examination expectations, interventions and reward events calendared between now and June 2019. It continues to be a pleasure working with Year 11 and we look forward to supporting this year group to a series of examination results that leave behind the legacy of an exceptional year group.

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## 1. Countdown Plans

Year 11 have been issued with a countdown planning book which holds all of the countdown revision plans for every subject. The full covering letter and countdown book can be found on the school website under the 'Parents' section alongside the examination timetable and revision tips and strategies:

The countdown plans are designed to reduce student anxiety through early preparation and to enable parents to specifically identify areas of revision to support with at home. It is recommended that students revise or complete homework for 2 hours a night during the week and then 6 hours over the weekend. We are currently (week commencing 11.03.19) on **week 14**.

#### 2. Crash Program and Pep Talks

Please find attached to this letter a copy of the crash program and the pep talks. The crash program is designed to give students intensive revision opportunities prior to their GCSE examinations in English, Maths, Science, History, Philosophy & Ethics and Geography. The pep talks are for all subjects and take place immediately before examinations to ensure that students are focused and remind them about exam technique. Attendance at both crash sessions and pep talks is compulsory as we know from previous experience how valuable this preparation is.

# Up until Friday 7<sup>th</sup> June, where students are not in examinations, crash sessions or pep talks, normal lessons will continue.

## 3. <u>Study leave</u>

The last day students will be expected to attend school for the entire school day between 8:45am and 3:25pm for normal lessons is Friday 7<sup>th</sup> June. However there are still a number of examinations, crash sessions and pep talks timetabled in the week commencing the 10<sup>th</sup> June and beyond. Students will be expected to come in for all timetabled sessions and examinations but can be picked up or make their own way home immediately afterwards. If a student is unable to be picked up or make their own way home, independent supervised study rooms will be available on site. Normal school transport will of course operate during the examination period.

From Monday 10<sup>th</sup> June, students will not be registered in lessons or tutor time, therefore all students will need to sign in and out at the student office so that we aware of exactly who is on site. Students are responsible for studying independently when they are not in school until their last examination has been completed.

# 4. Uniform

Year 11 students will be expected to attend school in their regular school uniform until Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June. Where examinations, crash sessions or pep talks take place after this date, students are also expected to attend in uniform. They will be permitted to wear their leavers' hoodie as part of their uniform in place of their blazer. Year 11 students will be permitted to wear summer polo shirts after the half term break in line with the rest of the school.

## 5. Leavers' Day

Leavers' Day is to take place on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June. All students have a Science examination in the morning. After this examination has finished, there will be an opportunity for them to sign each other's shirts if they so wish. As students will probably be wearing uniform with polo shirts by this point, they may wish to bring in an old more formal school shirt for signing. There will then be a final celebration assembly on the school site before we head down to Cloakham Lawns for a celebration event including a barbecue and rounders. Parents are also welcome to join us at Cloakham Lawns between 1:30pm – 3:00pm. The dress code for students on this day will be smart casual and students will need to change at school after the shirt signing and before the final assembly. Appropriate changing areas will be provided.

# We would welcome students donated any unwanted uniform back to AVA. They can leave this at reception at any point.

6. <u>Prom</u>

Our prom will take place on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> June at Hornsbury Mill in Chard. Students can arrive from 7:00pm for a 7:30pm start. The gateway will be open for you to pay from April. The prom is a more formal event and therefore students will wish to dress appropriately. The event ends at 11:00pm and therefore students will need to be collected at this time.

# 7. Presentation Evening

Presentation Evening this year will be on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> September from 6:30pm at The Guildhall in Axminster. We would like students and parents to put this into their calendar early as we would like to reunite as many of the year group as possible to celebrate all of their academic, sporting and musical achievements. The dress code for this will be smart and all parents are encouraged to attend. A formal invite will be sent out at the very beginning of September to all past Y11 students and their parents. The evening will comprise welcome reception drinks, a formal speech from the Chair of Governors and Headteacher as well as awards led by all staff. There will also be a photography space where we will be taking individual and group photos alongside parents and other family members.
