

Weekly French Revision Plan

You should be spending at least 1 hour a week on French revision in the run up to exams and you should start your revision programme early.

Regular revision is the key to success at GCSE – remember ‘**little, but often**’ – 15 mins focussed **active** revision followed by a short break preferably in another room.

- Use Memrise to help you remember tricky words or expression.
- Use GCSEpod to help you revise.
- Practice questions and mark them – ask yourself - Why did you drop marks? What do you still need to learn?
