RE: Activity day – Thursday 18th July

As activity day creeps ever closer I wanted to update you on the in-school provision for the day. For those who have decided to stay on site during the day we will be offering three options (see below). Students need to choose one of the options (more specific information will come out next week) and they will spend the day doing the selected activity.

Option 1 – Multisports

Students will participate in a variety of sports throughout the day. Activities will include rounders (field), football (AGP), Badminton/Tennis (hall/hardcourt) and possibly swimming (TBC - there will be a small cost). This will be led by Mr Scott.

Option 2 – Journalism – BBC Young Reporter

The day will involve looking at media literacy and the skills needed for journalism. There will be opportunities for students to look at the pathways into this career so they can have their future voices heard.
