Dear Year 10 Parents & Carers

Partial Reopening for Year 10 Students

You may be aware that on the 24th May the Prime Minister announced that secondary schools should plan on the basis that from the week commencing 15th June, they can invite Year 10 pupils back into school for some face-to-face support with their teachers, subject to the Government's 5 tests being met. The guidance is in line with our current planning, however this means our timeline for reopening will be pushed back by 1 week.

This means that:

- Home learning will continue to be set for Year 10
- No Year 10 students will return before week commencing 15th June
- Week commencing 8th June an information pack including expectations, home school agreement and timetable will be sent to every Year 10 student
- We plan to offer face-to-face contact with staff for Year 10 on site week commencing 15th June
- Year 10 students will be in a set class of less than 15 and invited in for 1 day per week in that 'bubble'. This day is not negotiable
- All parents and students planning to take up their place from 15th June must have returned a signed home school agreement

If you haven't yet done so can you please complete this survey as a matter of urgency to aid with our planning processes.
