GCSE Results Day

As we move toward the end of the academic year we are gradually receiving more information and guidance regarding the examinations results day on Thursday 20th August 2020 and how this will be prepared. You may have seen that there have been further recent announcements that there will be an examination series in the Autumn term to provide an opportunity to sit an examination should you be disappointed with any grades that you receive this summer.

GCSE results day is still going ahead on the original release date of **Thursday 20th August 2020**, however it is important to note that this will look very different to previous years. We will make sure that Axe Valley will be fully COVID secure on results day and follow the Government guidance strictly. As such the following safety measures will be in place:

- A limited number of staff will be on site for results day including the Senior Leadership team and Examinations Officer. They will be wearing the correct PPE when handling results envelopes
- Students will be provided with a time slot to limit the number of students on site at any one time
- There will be a strict one way system in place
- Hand sanitiser will be provided on entry and throughout the hall

We will have no choice but to apply a strict rule where **if you have not arrived during your time slot you will not be allowed entry**.
