Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Year 10 Period 6 Lessons

All of us teachers of Year 10 have been so glad to get our students back after lockdown, teaching them in school. We know that home learning was not a complete substitute for lessons in school, meaning that gaps in knowledge and skills have emerged for some students. Looking forward to GCSE and other qualifications for current Year 10s, we are doing our utmost to close these gaps in our lesson time but would like to offer you and your child more.

We will be providing additional lesson time for Year 10 students for six weeks according to the schedule below, with 'Period 6' after school. Our Year 11s have benefited from Period 6 for most of this academic year, strengthening their knowledge and understanding ready for finishing Key Stage 4. We believe our Year 10s will benefit similarly from the same kind of provision and believe it will help them to feel confident going into Year 11.

Here is the plan:

- From Monday 17th May, the schedule in the table below commences. As you can see, there is a two-week cycle (just like our lesson timetable) of after-school tuition for most subjects.
- These lessons take place with student's normal teachers, from 3:40 4:30 on the days indicated. (This allows students to take a break just after the end of the normal school day.)
- Apart from where indicated in the timetable, these Period 6 sessions take place in students' normal classrooms.
- The schedule of period 6 lessons continues until Thursday 10th June, then there is a break for the next two weeks as Year 10 students will have end of year exams at this time.
- Period 6 will start up again on Monday 28th June, through to Thursday 15th July, following the same timetable (below).
- These are voluntary sessions for students but we strongly encourage attendance for all; as I said, almost all our Year 11s attended and benefited so much.
