Dear Parents and Carers,

I, Mrs Ward, am writing to introduce myself as your child's new year leader. I officially take over their year group on Monday 7th June but I aim to use this week to get to know some of the young people before this date. I will be supported by Mrs Sandie Tregale, Pastoral Support Co-ordinator, who I am sure a number of you are familiar with. We are really looking forward to working with the new Year 10 and Year 11 and supporting them to become the most successful young people they can be.

Every year, I take on the new Year 11s to support them through examinations, post-16 applications and preparation for the world of work.
