## Lateral Flow Device (LFD) Testing

In line with the current Government guidance, we will be arranging LFD testing for all students on site before they return to school. As previously this will take place in the school hall with each tutor group being allocated a time slot to attend for their LFD test. The details of how to attend for your LFD test will be sent to you at the end of the summer break. We already have parental consent regarding the LFD testing for students across current year groups 7-10 and we will not require you to do this again. Current Year 6 parents will be



sent a link to an online form to be able to consent to the LFD testing. If you have any questions about this don't hesitate to contact us <u>admin@axevalley.devon.sch.uk</u>. For the last series of LFD testing parents found it helpful to know the approximate time slots well in advance which is below. Please note all students will only need to complete one LFD test before their first day back. We will again have an open slot every evening after school open to families who are unable to attend in the day.

## Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September – Year 7 only

The school will be open for an induction day for new Year 7 students only where they will spend the day getting to know their tutors, familiarising themselves with the site, meeting staff and experiencing their first full lessons. Students must be in full school uniform **excluding** a tie as their bespoke house tie will be gifted to them when they arrive. Year 7 should arrive through the bus park gates at the rear of school where they will be greeted and guided to their tutor bases by staff. To confirm Year 7 will not need to bring their PE kit on Monday.

## Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> September – all Year groups

All students will return and begin their day in their tutor bases which you will be informed of in due course. Students must be in full school uniform **excluding** a tie as their bespoke house tie will be gifted to them when they arrive. Students will be given their new timetables, have their uniforms and equipment checked and be presented with their House tie and badge. Students will start in lessons from P3. PE kit will not be needed on Tuesday.

# Axe Valley Academy - Uniform Code



The expectation at the Axe Valley Academy is that all students comply with the uniform code. They will be expected to wear the uniform appropriately and that all items are in good order. Students should take pride in their appearance, and be smart throughout the school day, including the journey to and from school.

- **Blazer**: Black, with Axe Valley Academy badge in gold embroidery. All students are required to wear the Academy blazer throughout the year. The blazer may be removed in lessons with permission from the teacher.
- Shirt/blouse: Plain white shirt that must be tucked in, with a formal collar. All top buttons must be fastened. All shirts must be tucked in. White polo shirts with the Academy shield can be worn during the second half of the summer term.
- Ties: AVA House clip-on ties are compulsory for all students.
- **Trousers**: If trousers are worn they must be plain and black (flares, tight fitting/straight leg and denim trousers are not permitted, this also includes trousers that have exposed zips and poppers).
- **Skirts**: If skirts are worn they must be the official Axe Valley Academy blue and gold skirt. The length must be no more than 2 inches above the knee (the skirts can be fitted by Thomas Moore).
- **Jumper**: Black jumper with the Academy shield can be worn underneath the blazer. The school blazer must be worn with the jumper.
- **Shoes**: Sensible, plain, flat, sturdy, leather and black-soled black footwear is essential. Trainers, boots and canvas shoes are not permitted.
- Socks: Socks must be plain and black.
- Tights: Tights must be plain, black and in good order (e.g. ripped tights will need replacing).
- Belts: Belts must be plain and black.
- **Coats/Jackets**: It is acceptable to wear a coat or jacket over blazers before and after school and during break and lunch. These must not be worn instead of blazers. Hooded jumpers are not permitted.
- Scarves/Hats: Scarves and hats can be worn before and after school and during break and lunch.
- **Hairstyles**: Hair colouring needs to be natural and discreet. Extremes of colour and styles are not permitted.
- **Make-up**: Make-up, if worn, should be discreet. Artificial nails (including gel nails) will not be permitted. Students are not permitted to wear nail varnish.
- Jewellery: One pair of small stud earrings/sleepers. Students are allowed to wear one ring. No other jewellery is acceptable e.g. bracelets and necklaces.
- **Facial piercing**: Facial piercing is not permitted. Students are advised that all types of bars/studs, including clear ones, are strictly not permitted. Internal ear piercings are also not permitted. Neither do we permit students to be in classes with piercings covered by plasters.
