



Dear Parent/Guardian,

WW1 History GCSE (Years 9-11) Residential 9th April 2019

We are excited to be proposing a school tour to Ypres to support our History GCSE unit on the Historic Environment.

Here are the key details about the planned trip:

- 3 days and 2 nights
- Departs on Tuesday 9th April 2019 (First Monday of the Easter Holidays)
- Returns on Thursday 11 April 2019
- The provisional cost is £275.00 per pupil (We may be able to reduce the overall cost, but price is dependent on the amount of students and the point when we have all the deposits in. The current discounted costing is based upon taking 85 students.)
- This price includes:
 - Return executive coach travel
 - Return channel crossings
 - The group size is 85 students
 - The adults accompanying the group will be to a ratio of 1 teacher to 15 students.

The itinerary for the trip will include a visit to Hill 60 famous for the 1915 Battle of Ypres, the Essex Farm Dressing Station, Historial de la Grande Guerre Museum, Lijssenthoek Military Cemetery and visitor centre, as well as attending the last post ceremony at Menin Gate, and some free time for shopping in Ypres. We are still finalising all the arrangements to give students the most varied, interesting and useful trip possible.

In addition to the tour cost, we recommend that your child has 50 euros spending money for the trip. (During the trip they will need to take responsibility for this, themselves) They will also require a current passport and an EHIC card, which you need to organise. At the start of the January term we will need to collect in any remaining passport details.

To secure a place for your son, daughter or ward on this trip, a non-refundable deposit of £50.00 is required, along with the completed permission slip by Friday 2nd November 2018. A further payment of £100.00 by Friday 7th December 2018.

The final payment is required by Friday 8th March 2019. (We will notify you about the final payment cost once we have the numbers in, and have negotiated the final price.)
