

Dear Parent/Carer,

re: Vaccination Catch Up Clinics

The National Childhood Immunisation Programme is available to ensure that all children are immunised against dangerous diseases. It is important that everyone keeps up their immunity so that these diseases do not occur more frequently within the population. The current immunisation schedule offers 2 doses of Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccine (1 in year 8 and 1 in year 9) to girls, and Diphtheria, Tetanus, Polio and Meningitis ACWY to year 9 boys and girls.

If your child has not been vaccinated this academic year at their school or GPs with the above vaccinations, please contact the Immunisation Team on 0300 247 0082 to book in to a Community Clinic appointment so this may be completed. The team will then complete a consent form with you over the phone and book you in to a clinic. Clinics that will be available are:
